Members are expected to attend a minimum of two meetings a month which include regular monthly meetings, garage committee or special workshop concerns. Members should not use an ACTC appointment for personal or political cause or self-interests. ALLEGHENY COUNTY TRANSIT COUNCIL

The Allegheny County Transit Council (ACTC) is a voluntary citizen's advisory group, established in 1986 to work with the Port Authority Board of Directors' Consumer Relations Committee.

Council participants help to provide a new channel of communication between passengers and Port Authority management as they offer public input in the identification of various commuter problems. Members also suggest ways to help resolve many of these concerns.

Membership is open to regular transit users, age 18 or older, from each of the six regions throughout Allegheny County served by Port Authority's five (5) bus divisions and one (1) light rail/trolley division. They represent a good cross section of patrons from the total "service area" and form a strong nucleus of individuals wanting to improve public transit. Regularly scheduled meetings are held monthly.
