



BUS STOP CONSOLIDATION PROPOSAL UPDATED

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE (December 5, 2019) - Port Authority's Service Development team has updated its Bus Stop Consolidation proposal for route 88-Penn that was announced yesterday.

The updated proposal eliminates fewer bus stops due to a calculation error.

Instead of proposing to eliminate 13 inbound and 12 outbound bus stops on the 88-Penn, the updated proposal now includes eliminating 11 inbound and 11 outbound stops.

The number of stops proposed to be eliminated on the 48-Arlington— 11 inbound and 12 outbound — has not changed.

Feedback on this proposal will be collected through February 7, 2020.
